A quorum for Alpine Division General Meetings is a majority of the head coaches present. A quorum was present. Eight full membership schools are represented by head coaches who are present, and a majority vote is 5 votes out of 8.

The meeting was called to order by Jack Walker, alpine director, at 9:40 a.m.

PRELIMINARIES:

1. The minutes of the spring meeting as posted on the OISRA web site were unanimously approved.
2. Treasurer reported that at the instruction of the Board the combined OISRA/Alpine bank account was closed and two accounts were opened. The Alpine account has a current balance of \$29,171.03.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. There was a presentation from the OISRA registrar on the registration for the coming season
 - General discussion regarding the need for certification of coaches who would be in control of any training or racing of teams.
 - It was pointed out that where you were a head coach of a team but as a certified coach worked with racers from other teams, you needed to list the names of the team that you wanted to be associated with on your C1 form. There is an updated C1 form on the web site that had a place for listing more than one team.
 - It was clarified that a team could only have one head coach. Where a team had both regular alpine and freestyle groups, the M1 listed Head coach would be the reference for the OISRA, and that the free style

coach would need be a certified coach, working for that or any teams he was training with and would be acting with at the State event.

- The Criminal Background Check form (CBC) had been re written, and coaches should pay attention to notifying who had carried out their CBC. USSA member coaches and instructors need to identify their current status within the USSA if they were identifying the USSA as having carried out their CBC.

2. David Moulton, the commissioner, gave a resume of the work he does during the season with assisting leagues, and his working with the state host league as Chief of the State Race Committee.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Saul Wold, the Emerald League rep who is overseeing this year's Alpine State event, gave a presentation of the planning for the 2014 State event at Willamette Pass.

- He advised that it would not be possible to hold a combined alpine and freestyle event at Willamette Pass, and there was some general discussion regarding this that was carried over to the Steering Committee meeting that followed.
- There was considerable discussion regarding the planning for the Willamette Pass event and it was obvious that the host committee had things well in hand.

2. Sportsmanship Committee Report. Garrett Shields, Grant High School assistant coach, gave a report on behalf of Randy Hewitt, the OISRA Sportsmanship director. Garrett Shields reported the progress made and the anticipated outreach for the coming season.

The meeting adjourned at noon.
