



## September 28, 2020 Covid-19 Update

OISRA believes that high school skiing can be a valuable component of a student's health and well-being, especially during the stress of dealing with the Covid-19 pandemic.

The OISRA administration is planning for a 2020-21 ski season, but we are currently in a "wait and see" stage, because high school skiing this season depends on

- the OHA (Oregon Health Authority) guidance for reopening high school sports
- OSAA (Oregon Schools Activities Association) sanctioning a winter sport schedule
- school athletic departments (or school boards) allowing winter sport participation
- availability of skiing venues for practice and racing.

Each division, Alpine and Nordic, will independently make the decision of whether they will have a 2020-21 ski season.

If a division decides to have a ski season, then registration details, scheduling changes, format changes, state championship options, etc. will be posted by that division. OISRA and its divisions will adhere to the Covid-19 guidelines established by OHA, OSAA, schools and venues.
